First, the order referenced in the Notice of Appeal, specifically the "Granting of Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment, of January 7, 2000," is not a final order disposing of all claims of all parties before the District Court and was not designated as a final order by the District Court pursuant to Rule 54(b), F.R.C.P. Second, the Order of Dismissal entered by the District Court on May 19, 2000, disposing of the claims of the remaining twelve plaintiffs, does not satisfy the requirements of Rule 58 that the judgment be set forth in a separate document.

Because no appealable judgment has been entered, this appeal is DISMISSED.
