PER CURIAM:*

Gerardo Antonio Flores-De La Cruz's appointed counsel has filed a motion for leave to withdraw as counsel and a brief in support in accordance with Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 744 (1967). Flores-De La Cruz has received a copy of counsel's motion and brief but has not filed a response. Although counsel did not address the validity of the revocation of Flores-De La Cruz's supervised release, our independent review of the record and counsel's brief reveals that both the revocation and the sentence were valid and that there are no nonfrivolous issues for

appeal. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities in this case, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED.
