Lorenzo Argueta petitions for review of the decision of the Board of Immigration Appeals dismissing his appeal from the immigration judge's decision to deny his application for asylum and for a withholding of deportation. He argues that the Board erred by determining that he did not have a well-founded fear of future persecution in Guatemala because of his union membership. We have reviewed the record and the briefs and determine that the Board's decision is supported by substantial evidence. See Carbajal-Gonzalez v. INS, 78 F.3d 194, 197 (5th Cir. 1996).
