PER CURIAM:*

Terina Renae Brown ("Brown"), federal inmate #30881-077, appeals the district court's denial of her 18 U.S.C. § 3582 motion for a reduction in her sentence. Brown received a stipulated sentence as permitted by FED. R. CRIM. P. 11(e)(1)(C). Because Brown's sentence was imposed in accordance with Rule 11(e)(1)(C), 18 U.S.C. 3582(c)(2) does not apply. Consequently, the district court did not abuse its discretion in
