PER CURIAM:*

Counsel appointed to represent Jared Lamont Hall has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Although he was notified of counsel's motion, Hall has filed no response.

Our independent review of counsel's brief and the record discloses no nonfrivolous issue for appeal with respect to Hall's conviction. As part of his plea agreement, Hall validly waived

his right to directly appeal his sentence on any ground. See
United States v. Portillo, 18 F.3d 290, 292 (5th Cir. 1994).

and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
