Appealing the judgment in a criminal case, Miguel Riscajche-Siquina raises an argument that he concedes is foreclosed by *United States v. Guerrero-Navarro*, 737 F.3d 976 (5th Cir. 2013), in which this court held that the residential burglary offense analyzed therein constitutes the enumerated generic crime of burglary of a dwelling and a crime of violence for purposes of U.S.S.G. § 2L1.2(b)(1)(A). *Guerrero-Navarro*, 737 F.3d at 980.
