PER CURIAM:*

Appealing the judgment in a criminal case, Hugo Aguirre raises an argument that he concedes is foreclosed by *United States v. Betancourt*, 586 F.3d 303, 308-09 (5th Cir. 2009), which held that knowledge of drug type and quantity is not an element of a 21 U.S.C. § 841 offense. Knowledge of drug type and quantity likewise is not an element of offenses under the related statutes of 21 U.S.C. § 952(a) and § 960(a). *See United States v. Valencia-*

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Gonzales, 172 F.3d 344, 345-46 (5th Cir. 1999); *United States v. Restrepo-Granda*, 575 F.2d 524, 527 (5th Cir. 1978). The unopposed motion for summary disposition is GRANTED, and the judgment of the district court is AFFIRMED.
