The appeal of Olmes Marin, in which court-appointed counsel has filed a brief pursuant to Anders v. California, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 993 (1967), raises no issue of arguable merit. Therefore, the motion of counsel to withdraw is GRANTED, and the appeal is DISMISSED. See United States v. Jackson, 578 F.2d 1162, 1164 (5th Cir. 1978); Fifth Cir. R. 42.2. The motion to substitute counsel on appeal is DISMISSED as moot.
