PER CURIAM:\*

The judgment of the district court is affirmed for essentially the reasons stated in its orders entered June 3, 1994 and April 25, 1995. In addition, we note Boyd's failure to comply with this court's briefing Rule 28.2.3, requiring page references to the district court record. Boyd's inattention to this briefing rule alone would have justified rejection of her appeal. Moore v. FDIC, 993 F.2d 106 (5th Cir. 1993). Further, Boyd's brief is devoid of a coherent legal argument for overturning the summary judgment.
