PER CURIAM:\*

Mary A. Harrison appeals the affirmance of the Commissioner's denial of his application for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits. She argues that the Commissioner erred in applying the listings regarding disability for obesity. As Harrison did not meet the height-weight requirements for the listing, the Commissioner did not err. 20 C.F.R. pt. 404, subpt. P, app. 1 § 10.10 (A-E) (1993). Harrison also contends that the Commissioner did not give adequate weight to the opinion of a

treating physician. The Commissioner is free to reject the opinion of any physician when the evidence supports a contrary conclusion. The substantial medical and other evidence supports the Commissioner's conclusion that Harrison's impairments did not significantly circumscribe her ability to do light work.

AFFIRMED.
