PER CURIAM:*

Hugh Robinson appeals his sentence for possession of cocaine with intent to distribute. Robinson argues that the district court clearly erred in holding him responsible for 9.961 kilograms of cocaine and in imposing a sentence enhancement for obstruction of justice. Having reviewed the record and the briefs of the parties, we AFFIRM. See United States v. Vital, 68 F.3d 114, 120 (5th Cir. 1995); United States v. Pofahl, 990 F.2d 1456, 1481-82 (5th Cir. 1993).
