PER CURIAM:*

Thomas F. Soderman appeals the district court's dismissal with prejudice of his civil rights action. Specifically, he contends that the district court erred in dismissing his claims for damages and declaratory relief against Officer Thomas Kibodeaux and Magistrate Judge James Blackstock. Because he has not sufficiently argued or briefed his other claims against Blackstock and Kibodeaux and his claims against the other defendants, they are considered abandoned, and we will not

address them. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error.

We also warn Soderman that he should examine any pending filings to determine their merit and that any abuse of the judicial system will open Soderman to the possibility of monetary sanctions.
