PER CURIAM:*

Gheorghe Dumbraveanu petitions this court to review the decision of the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) denying his applications for asylum and withholding of deportation. Mr. Dumbraveanu argues that he was denied due process because a Board of Immigration Appeals transmittal letter he received indicates that the Immigration Judge who decided his case also sat on the panel who ruled on his appeal. A review of the supplemental record reveals that Mr. Dumbraveanu's impression is erroneous;

the Immigration Judge before whom he appeared for his asylum hearing was not a member of the panel who decided the appeal.

Mr. Dumbraveanu also contends that he established a well-founded fear of persecution based on his political opinion. We have reviewed the record, the BIA's decision, and the briefs and determine that the evidence does not compel reversal of the BIA's determination. Chun v. INS, 40 F.3d 76, 78 (5th Cir. 1994).
