Suzette Elwonger appeals the district court's order granting the motion for summary judgment in favor of defendants, Bruce Crowell and Mike Scott. Elwonger argues that the district court erred in holding that Crowell was entitled to qualified immunity for his actions in obtaining and executing an arrest warrant against her.
