John Henry Johnson, # 629320, appeals the dismissal of his suit pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(d), now § 1915(e)(2)(B)(i). Johnson contends that the defendants, two lawyers who represented him in a criminal trial and a private investigator, conspired to imprison him. He argues that they provided him with false information, withheld information and failed to prepare an adequate defense. We have reviewed the record and Johnson's

brief and AFFIRM the district court's dismissal for essentially the same reasons adopted by the district court. Johnson v. Garza, No. 3:95-CV-3134-P (N.D. Tex. Feb. 6, 1996). Johnson's motions are DENIED.
