PER CURIAM:*

Willie Ed Craft, #0028433, appeals from the district court's dismissal as frivolous pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) of his civil rights complaint. Craft contends that he stated a valid claim of deliberate indifference to his serious medical needs. We have reviewed the record and Craft's brief and conclude that his appeal is frivolous. We caution Craft that any additional

frivolous appeals filed by him or on his behalf will invite the imposition of sanctions. To avoid sanctions, Craft is further cautioned to review any pending appeals to ensure that they do not raise arguments that are frivolous.

Craft's motions for copies of his medical records and for return of his copy of his appellate brief are DENIED.
