Louis Bernard Davis is a codefendant of Deon Tarral McDaniel, both having been charged with robbery and use of a firearm in a crime of violence. Davis also pleaded guilty and was sentenced with McDaniel. Davis appeals his guilty-plea conviction and sentence. The pertinent facts of both appeals are identical, and Davis raises essentially the same claims as
