PER CURIAM:*

In this Title VII employment discrimination case, Plaintiff-Appellant Wilbur L. Willis appeals from the district court's grant of summary judgment, dismissing his action against Defendant-Appellee ITT Educational Services, Inc., d/b/a ITT Technical Institute. After reviewing de novo all of the facts as presented

by the parties, we reach the same conclusion as did the district court — for the reasons advanced by that court — and append hereto a copy of the transcript of the district court's oral ruling.² Accordingly, the judgment of the district court, is, in all respects, affirmed at appellant's cost. The parties' respective motions for attorney's fees are denied.
