PER CURIAM:*

Audencio Coronado-Contreras appeals the two-level increase in his offense level for possession of a dangerous weapon under U.S.S.G. § 2D1.1. Coronado-Contreras argues that it was clearly improbable that the seized rifles were involved in the heroin trafficking activities with which he was charged. The district court did not clearly err in applying the two-level increase. See United States v. Garza, 118 F.3d 278, 285 (5th Cir. 1997); United States v. Flucas, 99 F.3d 177, 179 (5th Cir. 1997).
