PER CURIAM:*

Elbert Silas Green, a Texas prisoner (# 764049), appeals from the magistrate judge's order dismissing his civil rights complaint without prejudice based on his failure to comply with a March 6, 1997, district court order directing him to file a copy of his inmate trust account statement in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(2), as amended by the Prison Litigation Reform

Act ("PLRA"). The magistrate judge did not abuse its discretion in dismissing Green's complaint, as the burden of ensuring that the account statement was produced fell on Green. See Long v. Simmons, 77 F.3d 878, 879 (5th Cir. 1996); Morrow v. Collins, 111 F.3d 374, 375 (5th Cir. 1997). Accordingly, the district court's judgment is AFFIRMED.
