PER CURIAM:*

Richard Terrance Ayers, Texas prisoner No. 468361, appeals the summary-judgment dismissal of his civil rights claims against Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) Chaplain Stanley Wilson. Ayers argues that the summary-judgment evidence shows that there are disputed material facts and that the district court erred in concluding that Chaplain Wilson had no

constitutional duty to help Ayers resolve his problems with the TDCJ food service. Having reviewed the record and the briefs of the parties, we AFFIRM for essentially the reasons set forth by the magistrate judge.**
