PER CURIAM:*

Earnest Brishun Love, Texas state prisoner #584043, appeals the denial of his motion for enforcement of a consent decree and for civil contempt, contending

that prison officials are denying him the right to freely practice his religion. Our review of the record discloses no reversible error. Love has failed to show that the district court's denial of his motion was an abuse of discretion.² Accordingly, the judgment of the district court is AFFIRMED.
