PER CURIAM:*

Carlos Demour Dale, Texas prisoner # 769023, appeals from the magistrate judge's order granting summary judgment in favor of Officer Bridges and dismissing Dale's claim under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Dale contends that, in granting the motion, the magistrate judge overlooked the existence of genuine issues of fact which are material to his claims of excessive force and denial of adequate medical care.

A thorough review of the record reveals that Dale has failed to establish a valid claim for either excessive force or denial of adequate medical care. See Little v. Liquid Air Corp., 37 F.3d 1069, 1075 (5th Cir. 1994)(en banc); Siglar v. Hightower, 112 F.3d 191, 193-94 (5th Cir. 1997).
