PER CURIAM:*

Joyce Marie Pinson, federal prisoner # 18539-077, appeals the denial of her motion for post-conviction rehabilitation relief. Given that Pinson's motion did not satisfy the requirements of 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2), 18 U.S.C. § 3742, or Fed. R. Crim. P. 35, the district court was without authority to entertain it. See United States v. Early, 27 F.3d 140, 142 (5th Cir. 1994). This court AFFIRMS the denial of the motion based on the district court's lack of jurisdiction. Id.
