

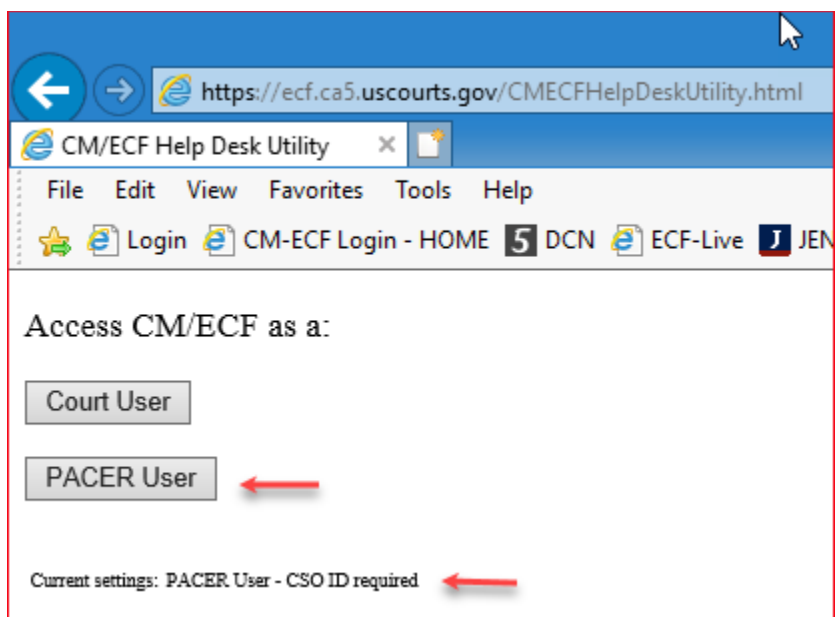
Court Reporters with Jenie Accounts

When a Jenie user attempts to access an outside URL (.gov), the system will automatically redirect the user to the inside server (.dcn). In order to override this automatic behavior, the system needs to see you as a public filer instead of as a Jenie user.

1) Open a browser. Click the link below, or, paste this URL into the browser address bar and hit ENTER.

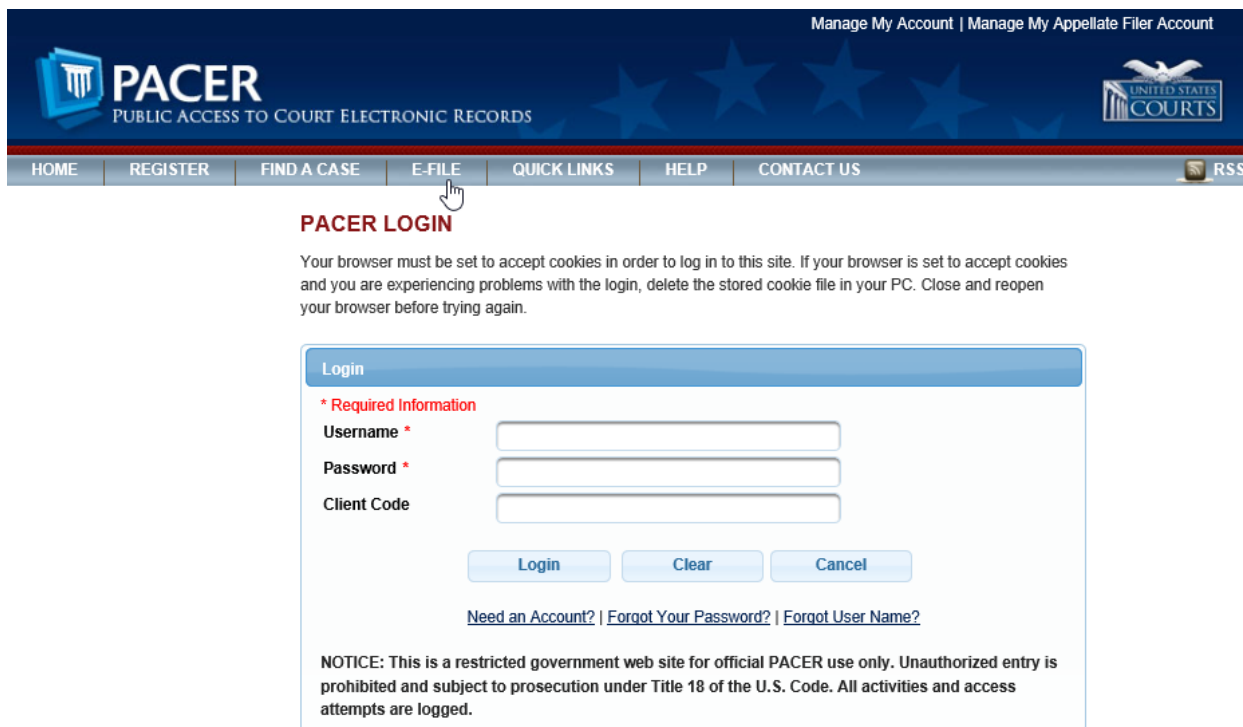
