



Accessing CM/ECF as a PACER User

When a court user who is logged into JENIE attempts to access an outside URL (.gov), the system will automatically redirect to the inside server URL (.dcn). The below utility will allow the court user to access CM/ECF through the PACER login (.gov) instead of the JENIE login (.dcn).

1. Click the link to access the utility: <https://ecf.ca5.uscourts.gov/CMECFHelpDeskUtility.html>
2. Click [PACER User] to access CM/ECF through PACER.




