
MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a state prisoner, complains that the subject United States Circuit Judge “violat[ed] my protected civil rights states [sic] and constitutional laws” by dismissing a judicial misconduct complaint complainant filed in September 2017 against a United States District Judge.

The complaint relates directly to the merits of the subject judge’s decision, and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
