MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a state pretrial detainee, complains that the subject United States District Judge’s denials of his “motions to implicate additional defendants . . . ignored very clear facts” and “ignored all evidence.” He further complains that the judge erroneously denied his motions to appoint counsel. Complainant contends that the judge’s denials of “any reasonable request and constitutional right” are “the epitom[e] of bad behavior on behalf of a judge.”

These allegations relate directly to the merits of decisions or procedural rulings and are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
