## MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a federal prisoner, alleges that the subject United States District Judge violated his Constitutional rights by improperly exercising federal jurisdiction over complainant’s criminal proceeding in which: there was no “offense against the United States”; complainant was “arrested and kidnapped due to an illegally issued warrant”; “no evidence of drug trafficking was proven or have occurred or would have occurred within or into the [federal district]”; and complainant’s guilty plea “was coerced.”

These allegations relate directly to the merits of decisions or procedural rulings and are therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
