MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a federal prisoner, alleges that the subject United States District Judge “refused to recognize the Constitutional Suprem[a]cy of Habeas Corpus right to relief from illegal detention,” and that her “willful and malfeasant behaviors. . . [are] in direct opposition of her ‘Good behavior’ clause assurances.”

The complaint relates directly to the merits of a decision or procedural ruling and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
