PER CURIAM:*

River/Road Construction, Inc. (River/Road), challenges the district court's grant of summary judgment for the Plaquemines Parish Government (Parish) on River/Road's equal protection claim. River/Road argues that the Parish failed to meet its summary-judgment burden, thus improperly shifting the burden onto River/Road, and that River/Road met its burden as the nonmoving party. We have carefully reviewed the arguments and the appellate record. For essentially the same reasons given by the

district court in its memorandum order, River/Road Constr., Inc. v. Plaquemines Parish Gov't, No. 96-0467 (E.D. La. Dec. 11, 1996) (memorandum and order), we conclude that the district court did not err in its summary-judgment analysis and determination. See Little v. Liquid Air Corp., 37 F.3d 1069, 1075 (5th Cir. 1994) (en banc).
