PER CURIAM:*

Charlie Hood, Jr., as the administrator of the estate of his minor child, Charles Nicholas Hood, appeals the dismissal of his suit which challenged the constitutionality of a Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) eligibility regulation. The district court dismissed the complaint for lack of subject matter jurisdiction and for failure to state a claim upon which relief could be granted, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(1) and
