PER CURIAM:*

Khan Amed Arif seeks to appeal the denial by the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) of his motion to reconsider its October 22, 1996, decision and of his motion to reopen deportation proceedings. Arif asserts that the BIA failed to consider all of the evidence which he presented at the deportation proceedings and that there is new evidence warranting the reopening of the proceedings.

After reviewing the record before us, we conclude that the BIA did not abuse its discretion in denying both motions. See Ogbemudia v. I.N.S., 988 F.2d 595, 600 (5th Cir. 1993); Ghassan v. INS, 972 F.2d 631, 638 (5th Cir. 1992). The petition for review is DENIED.
